

# King James

King James was a black man from the line of Stewart (swarthy, black) Dynasty. He was the son of Henry and Mary Stewart (Mary of Scotts). The husband of Anne of Denmark and father of seven, King James VI over Scotland and first King James over Ireland commissioned the translation of the Holy Scriptures into English. This task began in 1605 and was completed in 1611.

In 1605, after the announcement of this work, there were failed assassination attempts by a group of provincial English Catholics. One noted was the Gunpowder Plot in which 36 barrels of gunpowder were to be used to blow up the House of Lords, King James's residence.

With blood lines going back to the Pictish-Scottish King Kenneth the Niger, James became King of Scotland in A.D. in 1567 through 1625. King James VI/I was the first to unite the British Isle in Scotland into what we know as Great Britain today. Following the death of his mother Mary of Scotts, King James was chosen to succeed her by his cousin Elizabeth of England. King James and wife Anne are the ninth great-grandparents of Elizabeth II. Choosing seventy of the best scholars of his time, he authorized translation of the scriptures and named it after himself giving us the Authorized King James Version, the main source of our Holy Scriptures today.
