

# THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO SAINT MATTHEW

- 1** THE book of the generation of **YAHOSHUA HA' MASHIAKH**, the son of Dawid, the son of Abraham.
- 2 Abraham begat Yitzkhaq; and Yitzkhaq begat Ya'aqob; and Ya'aqob begat **Yehudah (Judah/Jude/Judea)** and his brethren;
- 3 And Yehudah begat Peretz and Zerakh of Tamar; and Peretz begat Khetzron; and Khetzron begat Aram;
- 4 And Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab begat Nakhshon; and Nakhshon begat Salmah;
- 5 And Salmah begat Bo'az of Rakhah; and Bo'az begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Yishai;
- 6 And Yishai begat Dawid the king; and Dawid the king begat Shelomoh of her that had been the wife of Uriyah;
- 7 And Shelomoh begat Rekhabam; and Rekhabam begat Abiyah; and Abiyah begat Asa;
- 8 And Asa begat Yahoshaphat; and Yahoshaphat begat Yehoram; and Yehoram begat Uzziyah;
- 9 And Uzziyah begat Yotham; and Yotham begat Akhaz; and Akhaz begat Khizqiyahu;
- 10 And Khizqiyahu begat Manassheh; and Manassheh begat Amon; and Amon begat Yoshiyahu;
- 11 And Yoshiyahu begat Yekonyah and his brethren, about the time they were carried away to Babel:
- 12 And after they were brought to Babel, Yekonyah begat Shalti'el; and Shalti'el begat Zerubabel;
- 13 And Zerubabel begat Abihud; and Abihud begat El'yaqim; and El'yaqim begat Azor;
- 14 And Azor begat Tzadoq; and Tzadoq begat Yoqim; and Yoqim begat Elihud;
- 15 And Elihud begat Eleazar; and Eleazar begat Matthan; and Matthan begat Ya'aqob;
- 16 And Ya'aqob begat Yoseph the husband of **Miryam (Mary/Miriam)**, of whom was born **YAHOSHUA**, who is called **MASHIAKH**.
- 17 So all the generations from Abraham to Dawid are fourteen generations; and from Dawid until the carrying away into Babel are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babel unto **MASHIAKH** are fourteen generations.
- 18 Now the birth of **YAHOSHUA HA' MASHIAKH** was on this wise: When as his mother Miryam was espoused to Yoseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the **RUAKH HA' QODESH**.
- 19 Then Yoseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily.
- 20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the Angel of **YAHOWAH** appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Yoseph, thou son of Dawid, fear not to take unto thee Miryam thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the **RUAKH HA' QODESH**.
- 21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name **YAHOSHUA**: for he shall save his people from their sins.
- 22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of **YAHOWAH** by the prophet, saying,
- 23 ***"Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel"***, which being interpreted is, ELOHIM is with us.
- 24 Then Yoseph being raised from sleep did as the Angel of **YAHOWAH** had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:
- 25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name **YAHOSHUA**.
- 2** NOW when **YAHOSHUA** was born in Bethlekhem of Yehudah in the days of Hordos the king; behold, there came wise men from the east to Yerushalem,
- 2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Yehudim? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.
- 3 When Hordos the king had heard these things, he was troubled, and all Yerushalem with him.
- 4 And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where **MASHIAKH** should be born.
- 5 And they said unto him, In Bethlekhem of Yehudah: for thus it is written by the prophet,
- 6 ***"But thou, Bethlekhem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Yehudah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Yisra'EL."***
- 7 Then **Hordos (Herod)**, when he had privily called the wise men, enquired of them diligently what time the star appeared.
- 8 And he sent them to Bethlekhem, and said, Go and search diligently for the young child; and when ye have found him, bring me word again, that I may come and worship him also.
- 9 When they had heard the king, they departed; and, lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was.
- 10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy.
- 11 And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Miryam his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.
- 12 And being warned of ELOHIM in a dream that they should not return to Hordos, they departed into their own country another way.
